

Transportation & Emergency Evacuation Policy

Purpose:

In the event of an emergency, natural disaster, fire, or other unforeseen circumstances, it may be necessary to evacuate the premises and/or transport your child to a safe location or medical facility.

Evacuation Procedures:

- Children will be escorted by staff to a designated safe area near the property.
- In case of a fire, earthquake, or safety threat, evacuation will follow state and local safety protocols.
- A full attendance check will be conducted before and after evacuation.
- Parents/guardians will be notified as soon as safely possible.

Emergency Transportation:

If your child requires medical attention and emergency services (911) are called, your child may be transported by ambulance to the nearest medical facility.

If emergency transportation is needed for evacuation, your child will be safely transported with proper supervision, and you will be contacted immediately.

Designated Emergency Contact Location:

If evacuation requires relocation, parents will be contacted and informed of the exact pick-up location.
